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Poverty to Possibility

The Issues:



Over 16,000 people are living in low income households in Lambton County



In the fall of 2024 there were 886 people on the affordable housing wait list



An estimated 20,000 people in Lambton County experience food insecurity

Your United Way responds:

- 32,829 meals were delivered last year by Canadian Red Cross and LEO, 21% of these meals were fully subsidized, the remainder were partially subsidized based on income
- 33 residents at River City Vineyard last year secured permanent housing
- 4,122 income tax returns were completed last year generating \$15,972,247 in benefits for individuals in our community
- 121 people received emergency rent, medical, dental or hearing assistance

Impact:

48% of those using the income tax clinic did not need to access other social supports



100% of meals on wheels clients improved their nutritional status





United Way Sarnia-Lambton 84% of households were able to sustain their residency



Healthy People, Strong Communities

The Issues:



Almost half of Lambton County residents have experienced a form of mental health issue or condition in the past year



31,455 people living in Lambton County are 65 years of age or older, this is projected to climb to 39,257 by 2036



35% of rural homes in Lambton County are maintained by seniors



An estimated 27,000 Lambton County residents are in need of mental health counselling

Your United Way responds:

- 51,872 transportation trips were provided to seniors and those living with disabilities to attend medical and social appointments
- 58,799 tel check calls were made to those living in isolation or with mental health conditions
- **119 clients** in North Lambton received **947 hours** of care in order to successfully transition from hospital back to home
- 121 survivors of stroke or acquired brain injury had a safe place to go while giving their caregiver respite

94% of transportation clients were able to avoid trips to the hospital emergency department



Impact:

92% of those accessing mental health services had a reduction in their anxiety, depression, and feeling of isolation





United Way Sarnia-Lambton 100% of survivors participating in exercise were able

to maintain their level of fitness without digressing



All That Kids Can Be

The Issues:



21,528 children and youth live in poverty in Lambton County



Many of these 21,528 children go to school hungry which negatively affects their ability to learn



27% of youth report binge drinking and **20% of young** adults report weekly use of cannabis

Your United Way responds:

- 4,566 kids were able to get healthy food at school
- 720 kids were matched with a caring adult mentor, or participated in group mentor programs
- 1,323 kids attended out of school programs focused on developing skills to effectively solve problems, positively deal with challenges, resist peer pressure and avoid engagement in risky behaviour

Impact:

97% of kids participating in the funded programs demonstrated an overall improvement in success at school

98% of kids had a reduced absenteeism at school



82% of youth displayed increased self-confidence and personal growth



United Way Sarnia-Lambton 88% of youth have become more physically active



Summary

 20,105 people were directly impacted by United Way funded programs last year. This represents 16% of the population of Lambton County, an increase of 2% over last year; 6,930 of these were children.
